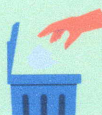

Carol Service

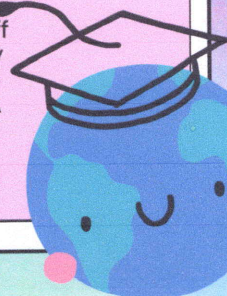
